INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. This Admit Card must be presented for verification along with at least one original (**not photocopy or scanned copy**) valid **photo identification card (College ID, Employer ID, Driving Licence, Passport, PAN Card, Voter ID card, Aadhaar card)**.
2. This admit card is valid only if the candidate's photograph and signature are legible.
3. Please report to the examination venue at least one hour before the commencement of the examination for identity verification.
4. Candidates will be permitted to appear for the examination **ONLY** after their credentials are verified by centre officials.
5. Candidates are required to occupy their allotted seats 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the examination.
6. Candidates are advised to locate the examination centre and its accessibility at least a day before the examination, so that they can reach the centre on time for the examination.
7. The total duration of the examination is **90** minutes. Any candidate arriving late will have examination time reduced proportionately.
8. No Candidate will be allowed to enter the examination centre 30 minutes after the scheduled start of the examination.
9. Candidates will not be permitted to leave the examination hall before the end of the examination.
10. Candidates should not bring any Charts/tables/loose sheets into the examination hall.
11. Mobile phones or any other electronic devices are **NOT ALLOWED** inside the examination centre. There may not be any facility for safe-keeping of these devices outside the examination centre. Hence, it will be prudent to leave them at your residence.
12. There is no facility for the safe keeping of bags and other belongings and parking facility for the vehicles is very limited. Institute will not responsible for any theft or mishap.
13. Candidates have to write their name and roll no. on the question paper and answer sheet, and put their signatures on each page of the question paper/answer sheet. The question paper must be returned to the invigilator after the end of the examination.
14. **There will be 100 multiple choice type questions. 80 questions will be related to Technical – Library Science while 20 questions will be of aptitude test (including General Knowledge, Reasoning, English Language etc.). The candidates are required to mark only one most correct answer to each question. Four marks will be awarded for each correct answer, while one mark will be deducted for each incorrect answer. No marks will be awarded for unanswered/unattempted question.**
15. **The candidate must wear face mask as per the prevailing COVID-19 guidelines.**
16. The candidate must bring their own **writing board, pen, pencil, eraser etc.**, for the examination.
